# TIC-TAC-TOE

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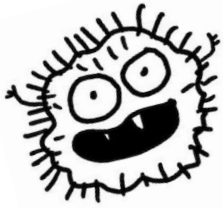
Find a partner at home and challenge them to a round of tic-tac-toe. Player 1 will be "X," while Player 2 will be "O." To win, you must get 3 in a row!

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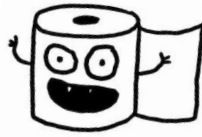

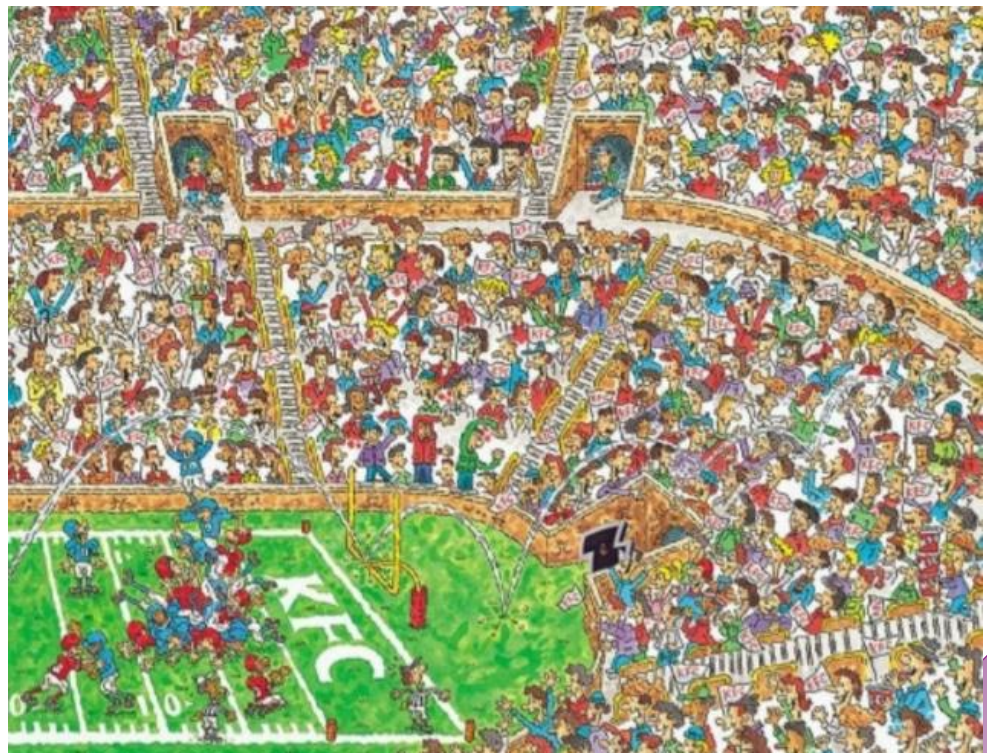

**LAST** (*Falling Action/Resolution*: Tie up the loose ends and bring the story to a close. What is the ultimate solution to the main problem? What is the final result of this solution?)

# EDIBLE SLIME

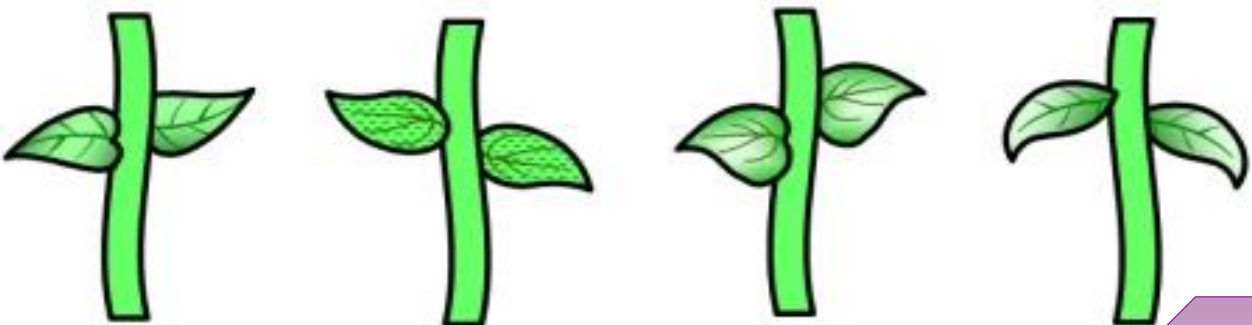


## SUPPLIES NEEDED

- MIXING BOWL
- MIXING SPOON
- 1 PKG. (0.6 OZ) JELL-O SUGAR FREE GELATIN
- 1 CUP CORNSTARCH
- ½ CUP HOT WATER

1. Combine dry gelatin mix and cornstarch in mixing bowl.
2. Add hot water.
3. Stir ingredients.
4. Knead with hands until the mixture is pliable and resembles the consistency of slime.

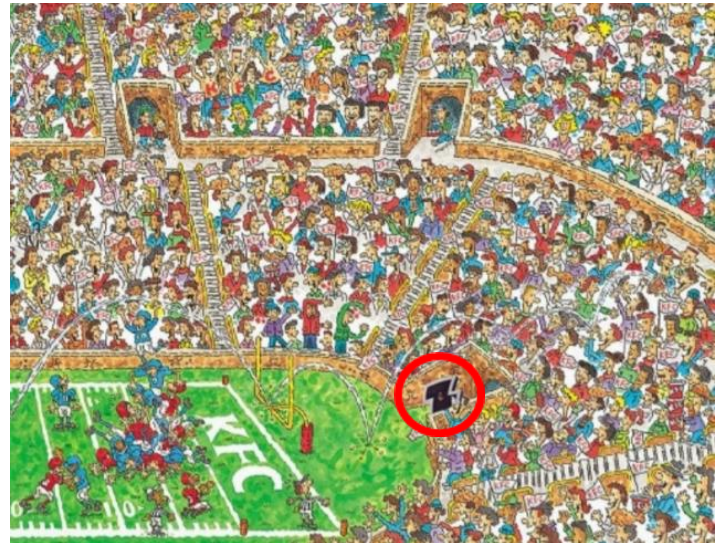
