



## **CRAFT**




These are notorious for falling off trees this time of year! They are often called helicopters or whirlybirds. Look in your yard or go for a short walk to gather some before starting this craft.

#### **Dragonfly Cards**

<u>Supplies:</u> Construction Paper / Card Stock, Paint, Elmer's Glue / Hot Glue, Helicopters

- 1. Fold your paper in half.
- 2. Use your finger to draw single lines around the page.
- 3. Glue 2-4 helicopters on top of the lines to resemble wings.
- 4. Let dry.
- 5. Write a nice message inside and deliver to a neighbor, family member or friend.







#### **Individual Dragonfly**

<u>Supplies:</u> Table Covering, Small Twigs, Helicopters, Paint, Paintbrush, Hot Glue

- 1. Lay out the helicopters on a covered table.
- 2. Paint the seeds with a paintbrush. You may choose any color.
- 3. Let dry.
- 4. Use hot glue to attach 4 helicopters onto the twig.
- 5. Stick the twig in a flowerpot to enjoy!




## **PIZZA PARTY**

Draw them on this pizza crust and write your creations in the box.




