- Front paws measure 3" in length & back paws measure 3-4".
- Fun fact: Their blacks masks help them see clearly by reducing glare.




- Paws measure 1-2" in length.
- Fun fact: A porcupine has approximately 30,000 quills on its body.



## COYOTE

- Front paws measure 2-3" in length & back paws measure 13/4-3".
- Fun fact: Coyotes have 42 teeth.



## **TURKEY**

- Tracks measure: 3¾-5" long by 4-5 ½" wide.
- Fun fact: An adult gobbler weighs 16 to 22 pounds on average.






Use the guidelines to cut out each animal track card. Punch a hole in the right corner and bind with a ring to carry on your camping adventures.

- Fun fact: Squirrels run erratically to confuse predators.



- Front paws measure \( \gamma\_8-1'' \) & back paws measure 2\( \gamma\_4'' \).
- Fun fact: More than half of the world's rabbits live in North America.



## DEER

- Tracks measure 3½-4" in length.
- Fun fact: Male deer grow a new set of antlers every year.



- Paws measure 2½" in length.
- Fun fact: Skunks do a warning dance before they spray.
