Benefits of the Project	A walking trail for fitness with benches to rest, fitness equipment on safety surfacing and accessible games court for multi-generational play provide plenty of choices for residents of any age or ability to play or exercise. The music and chess areas provide additional family fun and are shaded. The new area includes an accessible drinking fountain with bottle filler. There are new plantings and a pollinator garden as well as turf mounds for imaginative play. Located on the east side of the Center near the existing bocce courts this area gives older residents a space away from the preschool and traditional playground that can be used any time the park is open. The Adult Center specifically requested most of the items so they could expand their programs and activities outside. Time outside has additional benefits of socialization and increased mental and physical health,.




