AGREEMENT



This Agreement made this 22nd day of August, 2024,

by and between **PLAY ILLINOIS**, hereinafter called the "CONTRACTOR" and the ARLINGTON HEIGHTS PARK DISTRICT, hereinafter called the "PARK DISTRICT". WITNESSETH, that the CONTRACTOR and the PARK DISTRICT for the consideration stated herein agree as follows:
